THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

The Report of the Thirty-fourth Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary

The Thirty-fourth Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary was held in the Pro-Cathedral, May 13, 1914.

The meetings were preceded by the Celebration of the Holy Communion. The Rt. Rev. J. N. McCormick was the celebrant, assisted by Dean White and Archdeacon Huntington. The Bishop gave the address.

The president, Mrs. Collins Johnston, presided at the business meetings.

There were 15 branches represented, by twenty-seven delegates, and there were 39 guests from out of the city.

It was decided that the United Offering be collected twice a year, Sept. 29, the feast of St. Michael and All Angels, and March 25th, the feast of the Annunciation.

The group meetings are to be held: Hastings, Sept. 29th. Marshall, November 5th. Niles, January 6th. Ionia, April 5th. It was announced that a Diocesan branch of the Junior Auxiliary had been organized, and Mrs. J. E. Wilkinson of Manistee elected president, and she would be the 2nd vice-president in the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Bishop expressed a wish that we aim to increase our work, so that at the end of five years we might be independent of the Board of Missions. He also told of the Archdeacon's great help to the Diocese. Two new scholarships have been provided for, one by the relatives of Mrs. Hadley, to be used in Deaconess Hart's Training School for Girls, Hanchow, China, to be known as the Julia A. Hadley scholarship; and the other given by Muskegon, to be used at St. Mary's School for Girls, Rosebud Mission, So. Dakota, to be known as the Esther L. Eaglesfield Scholarship.

The Treasurer's report showed that \$1,509 had been given during the year.

It was voted to continue the Milwaukee plan of each branch giving one dollar a year towards Missionary work in the Province. Also that we continue the Pledge known as the Bishop Gillespie Memorial Fund. That a page of the Annual reports be given to the Girls' Friendly Society reports, and that the Junior Auxiliary money be sent through the Treasurer of the Woman's Auxiliary.
