## THE REPORT ON THE THIRTY-FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING OF WOMAN'S AUXILIARY OF THE DIOCESE OF WESTERN MICHIGAN

The Thirty-fifth annual meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary was held in the St. Thomas' Church, Battle Creek, May 11th, 1915.

The Bishop and six clergymen were in attendance. Eleven Parish Branches were represented by nineteen delegates, and forty guests from out of the city, making a total of 67. We also had with us Miss Thomas of Detroit, to represent the Lake Geneva Conference and the Rev. C. E. Betticher of Alaska.

The Rt. Rev. J. N. McCormick, D. D., was the celebrant at the Holy Communion assisted by the Rev. W. J. Lockton.

The Bishop gave the address, in which he spoke of and explained the Emergency Fund.

The business meeting was called at eleven o'clock and after the president's address, the various reports were given.

The report of boxes sent is much smaller, but is due to the fact that each Branch is trying to help with its Parish apportionment.

The Treasurer's report showed an increase of more than one hundred dollars over last year. This year it amounted to \$1,619.19.

There still remained to be filed \$21.00 on the Memorial Fund, and \$20.00 for the "Julia Cot." These were made up making a total of \$1,660.19.

In the Bishop's Charge to the Auxiliary, he asked that we continue the Memorial Fund, and announced that each Parish in the Diocese was at present provided with a rector; he also explained how a portable church is used in Pennsylvania.

The Group Meetings are to be held as follows: St. Joseph, Nov. 5; Ionia, Jan. 6; and Allegan, March, 4.

Archdeacon Huntington told of his work and needs, which called for four more missionaries; and the Rev. F. Roudenbush of Kalamazoo, spoke in behalf of the Lake Geneva Conference.

The ladies of St. Thomas' Church served a delicious luncheon to 110, which was greatly enjoyed.

Three invitations were extended for the next Annual Meeting: from Manistee, Hastings, and Kalamazoo. It will be decided before February.


