GUIDELINES FOR THE WITNESSING AND BLESSING OF A LIFELONG COVENANT IN A SAME-SEX RELATIONSHIP

- 1. The rite is contained in <u>Liturgical Resources 1: I will Bless you and You Will Be a Blessing</u>, issued by Church Publishing, Inc.
- 2. This rite does not constitute a marriage in either an ecclesiastical or legal sense, and that fact should be clearly stated in printed material or spoken announcements accompanying the use of the rite.
- 3. Before this rite and be used, the congregation/cluster involved will:
 - a. conduct a thorough study of the rite and related issues lead by the rector according to the materials found in Liturgical Resources 1;
 - b. the vestry/cluster council must support the use of the rite by a two-thirds majority;
 - c. the couple must receive at least five sessions of counseling using the materials supplied in <u>Liturgical Resources 1</u>;
 - d. the rite will not be used in the context of any regularly schedules services.
- 4. No priest or congregation shall be compelled to use the rite. No punishment can be imposed by any entity for not using the rite.
- 5. <u>Liturgical Resources 1</u> will be reviewed at the next General Convention in 2015.
